

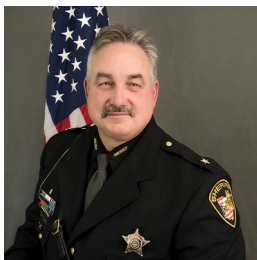


SCAM & FRAUD PREVENTION
